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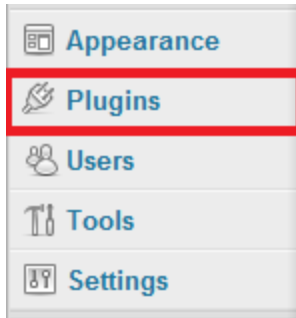
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Chapter 1 – Installation

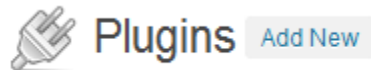
Hello and thank you for purchasing the EZ Price Tables Plugin. Let's get right to it.

Follow these simple steps to install the plugin.

1. Login to your Wordpress Dashboard as you normally would
2. On the left menu bar, click the "Plugins" Tab



3. Click the "Add New" button on the top



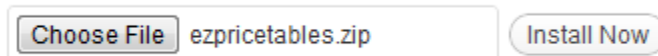
4. Click the "Upload" button.



5. Select where the file is located on your computer and click "Install Now"

6. Once the plugin is installed, click “Activate Plugin”

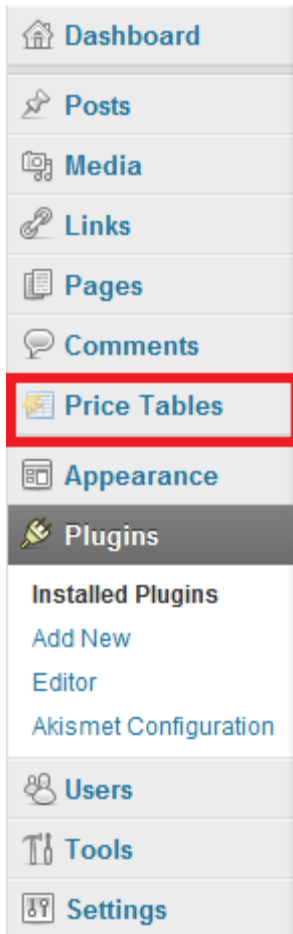

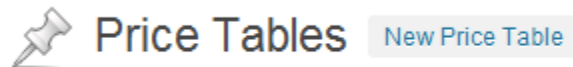
7. That's it! You should now see a “Price Table” tab on the left menu bar.




Chapter 2 – Creating and Setting Up Your Price Tables

Follow these easy steps to set up your price table.

1. Click the “Price Table” tab on the left side of your dashboard
2. In the page that appears, click the “New Price Table” Button




3. You will be taken to the EZ Price Table Dashboard. Have a look around and play around with the features. Fill in the details for the products/services you offer.

6. To change templates, pick and choose one from the drop down menu on the right. Click “Save Draft” again to refresh the preview.

7. Each template comes with their own specific notes and tips so be sure to read these.

Tips

Important:

Podcast People can be used with or without sidebox labels or checkmarks. Use %yes% token in feature fields where you want checkmark to appear.

Caution: each feature is constrained to only one line of text.

Caution: details fields are omitted in output.

8. Once you are happy with your price table, cut/copy the short code provided. It should look like [price_table id= "##"].

Choose Template: Podcast People ▼

To display this price table, copy/paste the following shortcode into any post or page:

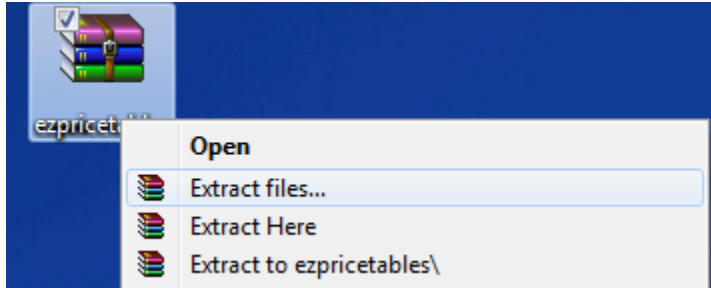

9. Paste this short code into and page or post to display the price table. And that's it!

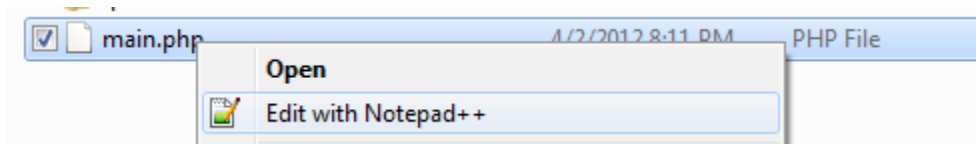
Chapter 3 – Rebranding the plugin

Before we begin, you will need to download and install a free program called [Notepad++](#). No programming experience is required, don't worry.

1. Locate the .zip file for the plugin. Right click and unzip the files.



2. You will find 2 folders – pricingtables and _macosx. Open the “pricingtables” folder.
3. Right click the main.php file and then click “Edit with Notepad++”

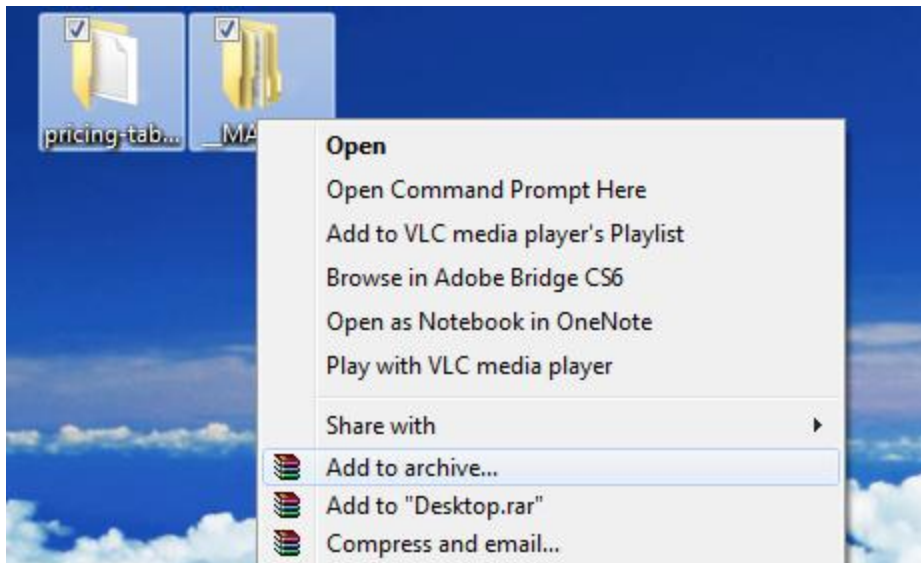


4. You can change any of the green text and put in whatever details you want. You are allowed to change the Plugin Name, the Plugin URI, Description, Author, and Author URI. It's best to leave the Version and License as is.

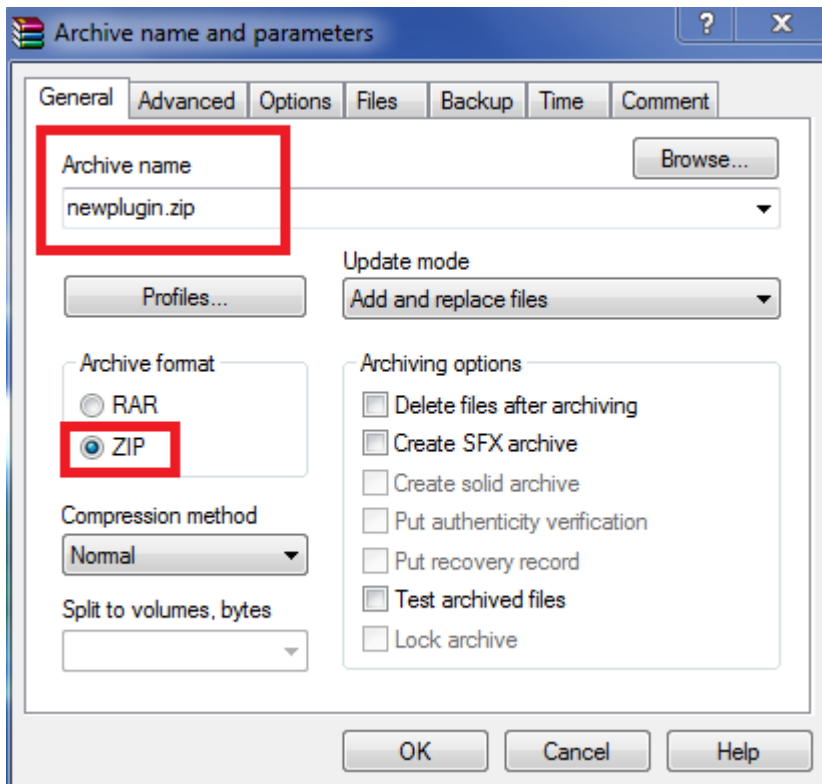

5. Click save.

- Now compress the two folders into a .zip file. Highlight the two folders, right click, and click “compress to archive”.



- Rename the plugin and make sure it is compressed to a .zip file. Click OK.



8. Now login to your Wordpress dashboard and install the plugin as you normally would.
9. Take a look at your plugin menu. It should now reflect the changes you made in the .php file.
